First Aid Strategy

- We probably won't get to choose our order for Branch, but if we do our preference would be to send:
 - 1. Lars
 - 2. Joel
 - 3. Sayuri
 - 4. Lauralee
- Our second preference would be to have Lauralee go in first. If they ask us for two volunteers, we simply make sure that Lars and Lauralee are not in the same group.
- Whoever ends up being the first guard will be in charge of the initial scene assessment (checking for dangers, finding out what happened, counting the patients, and phoning EMS)
- Whoever goes in first should set their watch, and make sure they leave to phone 9-1-1 after about 45 seconds
- Once Lars enters the scene, he will take over this role and make sure we have found all the patients (do a perimeter check), deal with any issues (tie people up), help corral patients, and make sure that everyone has equipment. Later in the scene (6-7 minutes in), he will make an update call.
- Once Joel enters the scene, he will get any patient that requires extrication, lifting, or a difficult spinal roll.
- Sayuri takes an unconscious patient (or one that looks like they will go unconscious soon).
- Lauralee get the more difficult conscious patient, and may need to help corral or treat more than one person depending on how many patients there are and what Lars is doing.

Event Tips

The key to getting marks in first aid is to do everything that is worth lots of marks slowly and carefully. Do the little things that are worth few marks quickly and efficiently.

Remember that your judge is still deciding on marks for a minute after the simulation is over. Remember to continue making a positive impression during this time. Thank your patient and your judge.
