# Joel's Sample Treatment

## First Aid: Unconscious Non-Breathing

### Scene Assessment (30 seconds)

- Hi my name is Joel and I'm a lifeguard
- I want you to stay still and remain clam while I ensure no dangers and make sure my gloves are on.
- What happened? [response]
- The mechanism of injury appears to be \_\_\_\_\_\_

## Primary Survey (60 seconds)

- Hello, can you hear me? Hello, can you me?
- No response to verbal or pain stimulus
- Assuming delicate spine, and maintaining immobilization
- Assessing the airway by looking in the mouth, don't see anything
- Doing a jaw thrust, and checking for breathing for a full ten seconds
  - Don't see chest rise/fall
  - Don't hear and breathing
  - Don't feel any air
- BREATH chest rise/fall BREATH
- Checking signs of circulation for a full ten seconds
- Despite no breathing, coughing or moving, I do feel a strong pulse
- BREATH I am continuing rescue breathing every 5 seconds while I start my RBS
- BREATH Checking under the back and legs for deadly bleeding
- BREATH Exposing the chest, looking for escaping air or other chest trauma
- BREATH Checking legs and arms for unstable fractures or medic alerts.

# Shock Treatment (20 seconds)

- BREATH sizing and inserting oral airway, checking acceptance
- BREATH airway is accepted, setting up oxygen at 15 lpm
- BREATH putting on a blanket and reassuring patient throughout
- *BREATH* you're doing great buddy it's going to be ok the ambulance is on the way!

# Vitals (40 seconds)

- BREATH Starting vitals at time \_\_\_\_\_. This is also my ABC reassessment
- BREATH Assessing LOC: Hello Hello Pinch Pinch. No response.
- BREATH Patient has no motor control, eye opening response, or verbal abilities or 3 on the GC Scale.
- BREATH Reassessing breathing and pulse for ten seconds. Pulse is feeling strong and regular, and I am still not seeing any signs of breathing.
- BREATH I got 13 beats in 10 seconds or 78 bpm. Correct?
- BREATH Respirations are assisted at 12 bpm with no difficulties.
- BREATH Eyes are equal & reactive. Both are about 4mm in this light. Correct?
- BREATH Skin is normal colour, warm, and dry, when compared to mine. Correct?

#### History (20 seconds)

- BREATH My patient's chief complaint is unconscious non-breathing
- BREATH History could be \_\_
- BREATH Looking for any identification or information on my patient
- BREATH Medications/Allergies/Medical History is unknown

#### Head to Toe (40 seconds)

- BREATH Checking head: around eyes, cheekbone, jaw, through hair, in & behind ears.
- BREATH Checking neck, along spine, trachea, collarbones, and shoulders
- BREATH Checking sternum, ribs around the back, along spine, and kidneys
- BREATH Checking 4 quadrants of the abdomen, pelvis and groin
- BREATH Checking one leg down to the foot; pulse, cap refill, and pain response
- BREATH Checking second leg down to the foot; pulse, cap refill, and pain response
- BREATH Checking one arm down to the hand; pulse, cap refill, and pain response
- BREATH Checking second arm down to the hand; pulse, cap refill, and pain response
